

## Anthony T. Yeung' s Academic Trip in Beijing and Tangshan

Dr. Anthony Yeung, one of the most famous spine endoscopic master, the former president of ISMISS (International Society of Minimal Intervention in Spine Surgery) and the inventor of the YESS technology, visited China and had academic exchanges with Chinese orthopedic peers on 16-17 March. The road show trip was arranged and sponsored through Bonovo Academic Alliance (BAA) program.

The first stop was Beijing Dongzhimen Hospital on 16 March. Dr. Tony Yeung' s visit started with a morning round accompanying with Dr. Lu Xinghui, the department chairman. Thereafter, Prof. Yeung gave a lecture to the orthopedic surgeons with both the western medicine and the Chinese medicine background. Prof. Yeung shared his experience with more than 10,000 cases in his spine endoscopic practice, Meanwhile he demonstrated YESS technology by video. All attendees were touched by Prof. Yeung' s advanced endoscopic skills and learned lots of valuable experience.





In spite of long distance traveling, Prof. Yeung also attended “the 1<sup>st</sup> Spine Minimally Invasive Surgery Symposium of Tangshan City” on 17 March. Prof. Yeung’s lecture gave the attendees a brand-new outlook of present endoscopic technology and acquired warm applause.
